Service-specific Internship in Small Animal Oncology

Term: 1-year

Hours: 5 days per week, plus participation in the 'out of hours' rota (weekend duties)

We are a rapidly growing oncology service at Anderson Moores Veterinary Specialists (AMVS) looking for an oncology intern. AMVS is a busy, multi-disciplinary, small animal referral practice located within the Hampshire countryside. The hospital is close to the historic city of Winchester (which is 1 hour from London by train).

We have a varied caseload of unusual and challenging cases and a close-knit, enthusiastic team. We continue to expand our clinical services and believe in a team approach to challenging cases. AMVS accepts referrals in soft tissue and orthopaedic surgery, internal medicine, oncology, neurology, cardiology, dermatology, pain management and physiotherapy. Our Specialist Clinicians are supported by a team of highly qualified registered veterinary nurses, nursing assistants and rotating and specialist interns and residents across multiple disciplines. AMVS has modern equipment, including radiography, echocardiography, electrocardiography, ultrasonography, fluoroscopy, MRI, CT and a chemotherapy suite.

We are offering a one-year Oncology Internship position to veterinarians wishing to advance their clinical training in oncology. The oncology team currently consists of a boarded specialist in oncology (Dip.ACVM), oncology clinician (RCVS advanced practitioner), two full time oncology nurses and one oncology technician. The service is also supported by rotating residents and interns from other services. The oncology intern will be involved in consultations, assessment, diagnostic procedures and treatment of oncology cases and contribute to the on-call rota.

The successful candidate should be keen to further develop and enhance the care and service for our patients and clients and to help with growing the oncology service. The intern will be supervised and work on a daily basis with the oncology team. The successful candidate will be expected to participate in journal clubs, intern seminars and to produce one publication during their period with us. The out of hours rota is likely to be 1 in 4 weekends and a weeknight on-call. The ideal candidate must have an enthusiasm for oncology and be a team player, with attention to detail.

This internship will be ideally suited for someone with previous general practice experience in the UK and some experience in oncology. The ideal candidate will have completed a rotating internship in a multidisciplinary referral centre.

To be considered for the role, candidates:

- Must hold MRCVS membership or hold a veterinary degree registrable with the RCVS.
- Be eligible to work in the United Kingdom.
- have excellent English language skills
- Have strong communication skills and a professional approach.

Please note that due to the location of our practice and the 'on call' responsibilities, having your own transport would be an advantage.
